The IQAC members met to discuss about the reports given by NAAC Committee who visited the Campus between 18th March to 21st March 2016 for the third cycle. Based on the report, following suggestions are made.

1. It is recommended that the Stake holders of our University, the Students have to be given priority. The Residential / Hostel facilities for the Students needs to be improved both in space / building and other amenities.
- 2* It is recommended that With the NIRF of 14th position in 2015-2016 University has to start working towards improving the ranking in 2016-2017.
- 3* It is recommended to improve the Alumni activities. LinkedIn and various Social media can be used for gathering the details of BU alumni.
- 4* It is recommended Based on the NAAC Recommendations IPR cell has to be established to encourage faculty members and research Scholars to file patent.

- 5* It is suggested that in view of improving the quality of research and teaching, all the faculty may be insisted to qualify themselves with Ph.D before 2018.
- 6* It is recommended that academic audit is mandatory. Quality parameters need to be defined quantitatively and the benchmarks need to be set for Academic audit.
- 7* It is recommended that the quality of teaching and course content should attract foreign students.
- 8* It is recommended that Academic Audit shall be conducted for the year 2016 in month of August.

ACTION TAKEN STATUS.

1. Efforts have been taken to improve space/ building and other amenities in hostel.
2. The major area to be focused.

IQAC members discussed and suggested the following improvements to be implemented in the university.

- * It is recommended that, Rapidly growing institutions like us, need to go for Management Information System for easy and quick administration. Our University has to take steps for installing MIS in the campus.
- * It is insisted that, with the development in Technology, for facilitating the staff, students and scholars to access the updated information and improve research innovations, free wi-fi throughout the campus shall be provided. This is essential for improving teaching techniques and create a good research ambience.
- * It is suggested that as our University is having 9 science departments involved in Research and Teaching. A common Sophisticated Instrumentation facility is mandatory. Major Sophisticated Instruments shall be housed in the common facility and it shall be made available to all researchers inside and outside campus. Hence a common Sophisticated Instrument facility has to be established in the campus.

- * It is suggested that as University has 8 departments supported by UGC-SAP. In pursuit of competing for university of Potential of Excellence, few departments have to join together to apply for centre for potential of Excellence in particular Area (CPEPA) which is the next step towards achieving UPE. Under the umbrella of research idea of one particular area of each SAP department, a few other non-SAP departments shall join together to expand the set research theme bringing out inter disciplinary approach for the research and improving the output.
- * It is recommended that as a social responsibility, our university shall take up the initiative of protecting nature by planting native trees in the campus. Being located in the green environment it is the duty of our University to maintain the ecosystem. Plantation of native trees need to be given emphasis.
- * It is insisted that outcome based education is the major focus in today's higher education policy. To achieve OBE, the University should take steps to modify the curriculum of the courses offered incorporating PO, CO, etc. All boards of studies need to be given proper instructions about implementing OBE in the curriculum.
