- * IOAC congratulate the NIRF team who have worked for securing place for BU in National Ranking.
- * IOAC appreciated the efforts of university in creating common Instrumentation facility to house all the sophisticated instruments at one point facilitating the researchers to utilise them optimally.
- * It is recommended that several departments having excellent academic credentials can apply for financial assistance to strengthen research especially to DST-FIST and UGC-SAP.
- * It is insisted that the faculty members should try to increase the number of research papers in journals as against the number of publications in conference proceedings.
- * It is suggested that to increase the number of review articles so as to increase the h-index of the university and therefore its visibility.
- * It is suggested that to improve the quality of research and introduce modern

Technologies, initiatives should be taken to increase number of foreign faculty members.

- * It is recommended that more attention need to be given to collaborations to improve interdisciplinary multi institutional participation in research and teaching. In this regard, there is a need to follow-up the international MOUs so that all are functional.
- * It is recommended that steps need to be taken for improving the use of ICT in teaching, evaluation and administrative process.

ACTION TAKEN STATUS.

- * Departments having excellent academic credentials is instructed to apply for financial assistance to strengthen research especially to DST-FIST and UGC-SAP.
- * Faculty members were advised to concentrate regarding publication.
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- * The faculty members from world ranked institutions are given airfare, accommodation and honorarium to visit BU as guest faculty.
- * The concerned department is responsible to follow up and make it more functional.

IGAC members met to discuss about the improvement measures to be implemented and after discussion, listed the following suggestions from:

- * It is suggested that under the direction of MHRD, every University has to start Institutional Innovation Council in their campus. Our University also shall take steps to establish IIC and shall perform activities as directed by MHRD to motivate students towards innovative thinking.
- * It is insisted that rapidly growing Institutions like us, need to go for Management Information System for easy and quick administration. Our University has to take steps for installing MIS in the campus.
- * It is suggested that Bharathiar University having scored among top 50 Universities in the national level consecutively for 5 years, it has to take step towards elevating the University in the Global ranking. For placing the University in top Global ranking, it has to improve its collaborations both at national and International level. Bharathiar University has to establish collaborations with International Universities and has to work towards sergening MOU for collaborative research and exchange programs.

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- * It is recommended that On par with the direction of UGC/MHRD online courses such as SWAYAM, MOOC need to be included in the curriculum of PG programs as mandatory. The online Courses complimenting the PG programs offered should be made available to the PG students. The BOS should make sure to give weightage to the online courses completed by the students to ensure enrolling of PG students for such courses.
- * It is suggested that university responsibility of 133 colleges should improve the sports facility to spot and encourage potential students in sports from all the affiliated colleges to use the facility and empower themselves to compete at national and International level.

ACTION TAKEN STATUS

- * Motivated students towards innovative thinking to start Institutional Innovation Council Under the direction of MHRD.
- * Installing MIS in the campus.
- * University has taken necessary steps to establish collaborations with International Universities and has to work towards signing MOU for collaborative research and exchange programs.
- * SWAYAM, MOOC has been started up and has been included in the curriculum of PG programs as mandatory.
- * Efforts were taken to improve the sports facility to spot and encourage potential students in sports from all the affiliated colleges to use the facility and empower themselves to compete at national and International level.
